Deacon Miller addresses issues of social injustice from his perspective as an African-American who grew up on the South Side of Chicago in the 1940's and 1950's. Today he addresses 21st-century examples of the same intolerance.

Deacon Miller views such social divisiveness as an example of “a human condition that is the result of what happens when one group seeks power by bullying another.”

He believes that no one can sit idly tolerant of the great injustices happening around the world.

“If God were to give us an 11th commandment,” Deacon Miller proposes, “I believe it would read: Thou shall not be a victim...a perpetrator...nor a bystander.”
